Your hosts support and are associated with the citizen movement Time For The Planet


Our Accomodations

With its location in the countryside and its bucolic setting, Clos Marcamps invites you to rest and relax.


Swimming Pool

Places of Cultural and Tourist Interest

The region has no shortage of cultural and tourist attractions. We can help you plan your visits in the Bordeaux area.

Pair-Non Pair Cave

The famous Pair-Non-Pair cave located in the commune of Prignac-et-Marcamps is one of the most remarkable prehistoric decorated caves belonging to the ancient Upper Paleolithic period. Its engraved bestiary, dating back more than 30,000 years, presents horses, ibexes, deer, mammoths and an exceptional figuration of a megaceros. Reservations are essential in high season..

Bourg-sur-Gironde and the Vineyards

The Côtes-de-Bourg vineyard has been present in our land since Roman times. On the banks of the Gironde Estuary, in a hilly area known as the "Little Switzerland of Gironde", how can you resist its charm and the appeal of its landscapes and privileged climate? At its heart, the small medieval village of Bourg-sur-Gironde and its numerous second-hand dealers.

Citadelle of Blaye

A quarter of an hour from Clos Marcamps, the Citadel of Blaye is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Marked by the History of France and by illustrious people, it invites you to discover magnificent panoramas over the largest estuary in Europe, the Gironde. It has kept intact the defence system put in place by Vauban with its 1.5 km of ramparts, its gates and its underground passages, as well as the buildings necessary for the proper functioning of a garrison.







Bordeaux

Only half an hour's drive from Clos Marcamps, the city of Bordeaux, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is an essential visit: Place de la Bourse and its water mirror, Saint-André cathedral, Capucins market, Sainte-Catherine shopping street, Cité du Vin...

Saint-Émilion

The pretty village of Saint-Emilion, known worldwide for its vineyards listed as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, is rich in historical architecture and varied wine-growing landscapes. Only half an hour's drive from Clos Marcamps, Saint-Emilion is a must-see during your stay.


Arcachon Bay

On the A10 freeway, exit 39a in the direction of Bourg. Clos Marcamps is located 7 kms and less than 10 minutes from the highway exit.

The nearest airport is Bordeaux-Merignac, located 40 kms and half an hour from Le Clos Marcamps. The TGV station is Bordeaux Saint-Jean located at 30 kms, and we are less than 10 minutes from the TER station of Saint-André-de-Cubzac.
